Our PLANNING MEETING is on November 23rd at 7 p.m. at the Hawkins' house. Come vote at this meeting.


Also see our financial report in this issue. We sold \$1050 in advertising and that offset our newsletter expenses so we covered events and added a little over \$150 into the treasury.

FINACIAL REPORT

Calendar Year 2008 beginning balance was \$7,543.11 as on January 1, 2008

2008 ending balance was \$5207.99 cash plus \$2200 in new trophies or \$7,407.69 total.


Other than purchasing trophies, expenses exceeded income by \$135.42 for the year.

Calendar Year 2009 beginning cash balance was \$5,207.99

2009 year to date cash balance now totals \$5,568.95 and trophies are about \$2000.

We sold \$1050 in newsletter advertising and reduced newsletter expenses from about \$275 per month to about \$25 per month. Our only significant expense now is the annual Concour d'Elegance trophies and event supplies like printing entry and judging forms. So our income exceeded expenses by \$161.26 this year. GH


