So it seems to me we need a Fall event as well, and Lo! Our friends at the British Motor Club of Utah have come to the rescue with an invitation to all WMJR members.


Roger and Jill Davis will be leading a drive up Wolf Creek Pass on Saturday October 10. Here is Roger's description:

"We'll meet at our usual place at the Hogle Zoo at 9am for a 9:30am departure, up Emigration Canyon. The route will take us on a short stretch of I-80 to Exit 146 and the Sinclair station at Silver Creek Jct., to meet up with others and a Drain & Gain.

"The route will take US-40 to Exit 4, U-248, through scenic Brown's Canyon. At the "T" intersection with U-32, we will turn R\right and travel through Peoa, Oakley, Kamas, and on to Francis. At the stop sign in Francis we'll turn left (East) and continue on U-35 up to the Wolf Creek Summit (9480') where parking will be off the road in a small area, with overflow on the shoulder of the road as we've

done in the past. Unfortunately, the gate to the larger parking area is already padlocked and not accessible to vehicles. As you'll recall, it is just a short walk to the tables in this area.

"After eating, members can continue east to Hanna and Tabiona, where they may turn around, retracing the route or turn right on U-208 and hook up with US-40 and back to Heber. Of course, retracing the route from the summit lunch area will make for a shorter route, time wise. There you have it. 
When the new James Bond movie "Spectre" comes out later this year, there's one thing audiences won't see: the millions of dollars of damaged cars left over from filming.

According to a Daily Mail interview with chief stunt coordinator Gary Powell, the new Bond film caused an estimated \$36 million in car damage alone.

"We set the record for smashing up cars on 'Spectre," said Powell. "In Rome, we wrecked millions of pounds' worth. They were going into the Vatican at top speeds of 110 mph. We shot one entire night for four seconds of film."

The Mail goes on to say that seven of the new Aston Martin DB10 sports cars, which were specifically designed for "Spectre," were totally destroyed in filming. Ten of the custom DB10s, which were a collaboration between Aston Martin design director Marek Reichman and "Spectre" director Sam Mendes, were made for this particular Bond movie.


