John Surtees Appointed Commander of the British Empire

John Surtees, the only person to win world championships on both four and two wheels, has been awarded a CBE in Britain's New Year's Honours list 2016.

John Surtees appointed CBE
The Order of the British Empire
"recognizes distinguished service to the arts and sciences,
public services outside the Civil
Service and work with charitable and welfare organisations of
all kinds." After being made a
Member of the British Empire
(MBE) in 1959 and an Officer
of the British Empire (OBE) in
2008, the 81-year-old has now
been honoured with Commander of the British Empire.

The award is in recognition of his services to motorsport and the charitable work of the Henry Surtees Foundation, named in honour of his son, who lost his life in a Formula 2 crash at Brands Hatch in 2009.

Upon the announcement John Surtees said "I am obviously honoured to receive this further recognition. It is recognition, as far as I am concerned, not only for myself but for the world of two and four wheeled sport and the teams I have worked with. Fast forward to more recent times I would thank and include in this honour all those that have helped and supported our dreams, ambitions and work for the Henry Sur-

tees Foundation."

John Surtees enjoyed a glittering competitive career dominating the British circuits in 1954 and 1955 before starting his World



Championship career on two wheels with winning the 500cc Isle of Man TT and the 500cc World Championship for the first time. John had ridden Triumph, Vincent, REG, NSU and Norton before joining MV Agusta. He recorded 38 motorcycle grand prix wins..

The Brit won four 500cc and three 350cc world titles from 1956-1960 alongside six Isle of Man TT victories.

John Surtees combined contesting and winning two World Motorcycle Championships in 1960 with being invited to join Colin Chapman's Lotus Formula One team to drive when his motorcycle com-

mitments allowed. He finished second in the British Grand Prix and set pole position and record lap and led the Portuguese Grand Prix until having to retire late in the race

Retiring from motorcycles at the end of 1960, after a seamless transition to four wheels, he took his first Formula One Grand Prix victory at the Nurburgring in 1963 in his first year at Ferrari before going on to win the world championship the following season.

He finished second in the 1966 Formula One World Championship driving two marques of car after his split from Ferrari and his joining the Cooper Maserati team. He won the prestigious inaugural Can-Am Sports Car Champi-

onship Series in America driving a Lola T70.A move to Honda followed for 1967 and with the RA 301 in which John played a large part in its development; he won the 1967 Italian Grand Prix at Monza.

Surtees also enjoyed considerable success in prototype sports cars winning at circuits such as Sebring, Nurburgring and Monza. He gained a podium at the Le Mans 24 Hours in 1964.

2016 JCNA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING & 2016 JCNA INTERNATIONAL JAGUAR FESTIVAL REGISTRATION TIPS

1. Registration for each event is a separate ticket so if you are registering for both the AGM and IJF events you will need to register for each event separately.

2. Remember your credentials (user id

and password) as you will need this information to change or continue your registration.

- 3. Each registrant will need to have a unique email address to register for an event/
- 4. Everyone attending the JCNA AGM and JCNA IJF must register. For each registration an identification badge will be created. If you and a guest are attending the AGM and/or the IJF you will each need to go through the registration process for each event you plan to attend.
- 5. It is not necessary to complete your registration in a single session. If you do not complete your registration you will receive an automatic email that lets you know you started entering your registration but did not finish. You can continue where you left off by signing into event registration.

NAVIGATING THE REGISTRATION SITE

- 1. When you look at the JCNA AGM/ IJF website for the first time you will notice an orange selection bar (vertical bar) on the left side of the screen. At the top you will see a copy of the event logo with a stack of options you can select from. To become familiar with the website click on each of the selections to review the content.
- 2. At the bottom of the orange selection

bar you will see \square . Click and the remaining selections will be displayed. You will know you are at the bottom of the list when you see the event countdown clock.

- 3. You can return to the previous screen by clicking the \square arrow. If you want to go to a different item in the orange selection bar just click the button corresponding to where you want to go.
- 4. On tiled screens i.e. the SCHEDULE button you will be presented with a series of large squares (tiles) with text centered in the middle. Click on the tile you are interested in knowing more about and the tile will flip displaying additional details. Click on the MORE INFORMATION button and a description of the activity will appear. In some cases the MORE INFORMATION button will link you to a corresponding website.

REGISTERING FOR THE AGM OR IJF

1. There are 2 ways to register for an

event. You can click on the large AGM & IJF REGISTRATION button (top left side of screen) or select the TICKETS+BUTTON midway down the orange selection bar. NOTE: if you click on the + next to the TICKETS button the ticket

choices will expand.

- 2. From the expanded ticket selection in the orange selection bar you will be able to select a specific type of ticket (AGM, IJF, Concours, Guests).
- 3. If you do not expand the TICKETS selection all ticket choices (AGM and IJF) will be displayed. Click on the specific type of ticket you want. If you do not see the ticket you want just scroll down using the scroll bar on the far right of the screen that will become visible when you hover over it.
- 4. To proceed with a specific ticket click on the CLICK TO REGISTER button (the orange button at the bottom of the tile you want to select).
- 5. When you see a ticket price of \$5 the fee is for the ticket. All pay to attend events must be purchased additionally. Attendance is only guaranteed for events that you registered for and have paid for.

"Quattro is just the name of the car," the Irishman retorted in disbelief, "Look at the papers, this car is designed to carry five persons."


"You can't pull that one on me," replies the Italian customs agent, "Quattro means four. You have five people in your car and are therefore breaking the law".
