














Continuing A New Section My Other Car Is A(n) ...

This month we offer for your admiration the lovely 1956 Austin-Healey 100 BN2 of Jim Revel. Jim provided this history of the car.




Not much is known about this car prior

to 1983, nor who the owner was until John France, now a retired Attorney from Rockford, IL informed me in 2016 that he ac-

quired it from his neighbor, Al Svododa, now deceased who claimed to be the 2nd owner, as he told John he bought it from the original owner a year earlier. As Al was an engineer he had disassembled it and when John visited him in 1983 said he had to sell it, so John bought it.

1984 In John contracted with Tom Kovacs. owner of Fourintune, a premiere Austin Healey restoration shop to do a complete off frame restoration of the car so Tom hauled the disassembled car to his restoration shop in Cedar-

restoration. Over the next 27 years John said he drove the car approximately 2,000 miles per year, so he put around 54,000 miles on it. During that time he participated in and drove it on many Austin Healey Club of America

rallys and events. Based on the odometer the first owner drove it over 90,000 miles before that but it stopped working not long after the

restoration.

In 2013 Bill Parthmer of York, PA acquired the car through an intermediary that John France contracted with to sell the car. Over the next 3 years Bill did approximately \$10,000 worth of replacements and upgraded mechanical work to the car including the restoration of all the gaug-

es and the speedo. Parthmer had a fancier car collection that he drove more often and said he put no than 500 more miles on the car during the 3 years he owned it. He had 97,483 miles put on the restored speedo which was what it said when
