Letter From WMJR President Barry Hanover

Obey Traffic Signs and Signals. ARTERIAL HIGHWAYS AND FULL STOPS 2d West—North Temple to City Limits.
State Street and North Temple.
Motor Av and State Street.
State Street from 9th South.
Salt Lake to 5th North in Provo. 21st South-State to 23d East. 5th East-9th South to 27th South. 9th East at 13th and 17th South. 11th East at 13th and 17th South.
13th East—1st South to 21st South.
Highland Dr—21st South to 33d South.
33d South from State to Tooele County Least South traffic, light signals. Keep Lights and Brakes in Good Order. Slow Down to Pass Schools and Children. No person under 16 years of age, allowed to ride a bicycle on any city street or operate an automobile. Remember That Occasionally You Are a destrian: 4 54 Give Right of Way to Police and Fire Departments and Ambulances. Don't Pass Any Part of a Standing Street Car. Always Pass to the Left of Vehicles Ahead of Give Way to Right When Signalled from Vehicles Coming from Your Right Have the Right of Way.
Speed Limit 15 Miles per Hour in Restricted Business District—30 Miles Outside.


